Can you help us get about five hundred copies of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico for free distribution to the students of Polytechnic Institute? We would like to honor the coming holiday, and think that if every student had a copy several days in advance we could encourage them to read it.

We would also like to have a convocation on Saturday morning at 10 a.m., July 24. We phoned to La Parguara this morning to inquire if you were there on your projected vacation, hoping that if you were you could be the speaker at this occasion. If you can come we would all be delighted. And if you cannot perhaps you can send someone who can speak with some authority about the constitution. Monday will be a holiday at the college.

There will be about four hundred and fifty students at the Convocation, plus the members of the faculty and staff.

If it so fitted into the plans of the Governor that he could be here on Saturday morning, that would of course be ideal. I will leave this up to your judgment.

Hoping to hear from you favorably, and remembering with great pleasure the several times when I heard you speak, and your promise to include some time at Polytechnic Institute in your vacation, I remain,
