The Federal Bar Association, established in Washington, D. C. in 1920, is a national association of members of the Federal judiciary and of lawyers who are or have been in the employ of the Federal Government. The Association has chapters in the principal cities.

The objects of the Association are: "to advance the science of jurisprudence; to promote the administration of justice; to uphold a high standard for the Federal judiciary, attorneys representing the Government of the United States, and attorneys appearing before courts, departments and agencies of the United States; to encourage cordial and friendly relations among the members of the legal profession; and to promote the welfare of attorneys employed by the Government of the United States."

The legal business of the government would be expedited with resultant benefits to the public were government lawyers and private practitioners brought into closer relationship. Effective means for bringing this about is through wide membership in the Federal Bar Association by private practitioners who may be eligible by reason of their former service as a member of the Federal judiciary or as a former civil or military employee with the Federal Government.

Among other benefits, membership in the Association entitles one to the Federal Bar Journal, the Federal Bar News, and participation in a most advantageous plan of group accident and sickness insurance underwritten by Mutual of Omaha.
