AMENDMENTS TO PROMOTIONAL POLICY

Page 1, I General Introduction

Paragraph 4, second sentence:

Change (b) and (c) to (a) and (b) and (a) to (c) so that the second sentence reads as follows:

" . . . . Department chairmen shall annually review the performance of department members and advise the dean regarding (a) change of rank, (b) change of salary, and (c) retention or dismissal of members who have not attained tenure."

Last paragraph:

Change to read as follows (new wording underscored):

"A member in probationary status may assume that his services have been satisfactory during a given academic year unless he is otherwise notified, in writing if he or the chairman so desires. If a chairman should recommend dismissal of a member in such status, or should advise the dean that such a member is not likely to be continued in service after the expiration of the probationary period, he shall immediately notify the department member in writing and give him an opportunity to present his case for retention to the dean before the latter acts on the chairman's recommendation. Similarly, when the dean, after consultation with the chairman, initiates the recommendation for dismissal, the faculty member shall have immediate notice and an opportunity to present his case to the academic vice president before a final decision is reached."
